Existing Control Measures
1. A waste code according to European waste catalogue (EWC) cannot be specified, due to dependence on the usage. Contact an authorized waste disposal service Hazardous waste: No. All empty packaging is to be returned to region and disposed of in Drum C
2. Do not dispose of waste into sewers. Do not contaminate ponds, waterways or ditches with chemical or used container. Send to an authorized waste disposal service. Contaminated packaging: Empty remaining content. Dispose of as unused product. Do not re-use empty containers.
3. Description of first aid measures In case of skin contact: Wash with plenty of water and soap. In case of eyes contact: Wash immediately with water. In case of Ingestion: Do not induce vomiting, get medical attention showing the SDS and the hazard label.
4. In case of Inhalation: Remove casualty to fresh air and keep warm and at rest.
5. Suitable extinguishing media: Water. Carbon dioxide (CO2).
6. Special hazards arising from the substance or mixture Do not inhale explosion and combustion gases.
7. Personal precautions, protective equipment and emergency procedures Wear personal protection equipment. Remove persons to safety
8. Environmental precautions Do not allow to enter into soil/subsoil. Do not allow to enter into surface water or drains. Limit leakages with earth or sand.
9. Methods and material for containment and cleaning up Suitable material for taking up: absorbing material, organic, sand Retain contaminated washing water and dispose it
10. Precautions for safe handling Avoid contact with skin and eyes, inhalation of vapours and mists. Do not eat or drink while working

11. Conditions for safe storage, including any incompatibilities Keep away from food, drink and feed

12. Eye protection: Not needed for normal use. Anyway, operate according good working practices EN ISO 166 for goggles

13. Protection for skin: No special precaution must be adopted for normal use EN ISO 374 for gloves
